## **Cookies**

A cookie is a small text file which is placed onto your device (eg computer, smartphone or other electronic device) when you use a website.

## **Types of cookies**

The cookies placed on your device fall into the following categories:

**Session (transient) cookies:** These cookies are erased when site visitors close their browsers and are not used to collect information from their computers. They typically store information in the form of a session identification that does not personally identify the user.

**Persistent (permanent or stored) cookies:** These cookies are stored on a site visitor's hard drive until they expire (at a set expiration date) or until they are deleted. These cookies are used to collect identifying information about the user, such as web surfing behaviour or user preferences for a specific site.

**Strictly necessary cookies:** These are the cookies that let your visitors browse through your site. They are also necessary for security reasons.

**Functional cookies:** These cookies "remember" registered visitors in order to improve their user experience.

**Performance cookie:** These cookies collect information about how you use our website, eg which pages you go to most often. These cookies do not collect personally identifiable information about you. All information collected by these cookies is aggregated and anonymous, and is only used to improve how our website works.
